Sacred amulet/shiviti making, commencing Saturday 6pm with shared meal, teaching and discussion and Havdalah; and continuing on Sunday with hands-on creative arts workshop

Rabbi Linda Motzkin is an artist, parchment maker, and *soferet* (Hebrew scribe) and creator of the Community Torah Project: a long-term educational endeavour to produce a Torah scroll with the assistance of hundreds of volunteers in the process, from transforming deerskins into parchment to proofreading completed panels.

Rabbi Jonathan Rubenstein is a baker and the founder of *Slice of Heaven Breads*, a non-profit, all-volunteer charitable bakery producing a variety of baked goods, supporting hunger relief and other charitable causes, and teaching the craft of bread-making from a Jewish spiritual perspective.
