Rabbi Linda is an artist and *soferet* – a practitioner of traditional Jewish scribal arts. She is currently leading the Community Torah Project, writing a Torah scroll with the assistance of hundreds of volunteers in the process of making the scroll, from transforming deerskins into parchment to proofreading completed panels. She is also the author of the Reform movement's four-volume Hebrew language curriculum for adult learners.

Rabbi Jonathan is a baker and the founder of Slice of Heaven Breads, a non-profit, all volunteer charitable bakery which produces a variety of baked goods. Slice of Heaven Breads supports hunger relief and other charitable causes, and teaches the craft of breadmaking from a Jewish spiritual perspective.
