## New Works by Rabbi Linda Motzkin

Tuesday, November 17 7 PM–8 PM

Rabbi Motzkin will talk about her original work, calligraphed upon pieces of handmade deerskin parchment and the process of creating these pieces. Her art consists on texts from the Bible and other sacred Jewish literature.

Rabbi Linda Motzkin, a *soferet* (Hebrew scribe), is one of a handful of women in the world engaged in this sacred craft. She is unique among female scribes in that she is the only one who hand makes her own parchment.

Rabbi Motzkin is co-rabbi, with her husband, Jonathan Rubenstein, of Temple Sinai of Saratoga Springs and High Holy Day Chaplain at Skidmore College.
